### 2021 PAY IT FORWARD SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION

The "Pay It Forward Scholarship Endowment" was established through the generosity of Mr. John E. and Leora Hieber, longtime members of Bel Air United Methodist Church. Its purpose is to provide funding for those seeking to further their education after high school. This may include traditional higher education, trade school, apprenticeships, or job training. Applicants may be:

- High school graduates/GED recipients; or
- Individuals currently in the workforce; seeking training or retraining; or
- Unemployed individuals seeking training or retraining

Preference will be given to the following:

- a. Individuals attending Bel Air United Methodist Church.
- b. Individuals who would be unable to continue schooling without financial assistance.
- c. Students who are committed to attending their first two years at a local community college or trade school.
- d. Students who show determination to attend college or attain further education/training.

After initial award, successful applicant(s) is/are encouraged to apply in succeeding years for renewal until conclusion of the education program. The applicant(s) must show evidence of successful progress and be working towards completing his/her program.

Recipients of this scholarship are encouraged to financially support the program when they are well-established in their careers.

All applicants are required to submit the following:

- Completed application form **including** a description of your future education and career goals and how this scholarship would assist you financially in attaining these goals.
- Transcript from the last educational institution attended - high school or college; a copy of your GED certificate is to be submitted if you withdrew from high school before earning a diploma.
