Dear friends,


You may remember that just before Christmas, I let you know of some sabbatical plans that I hope to do in the near future. I just wanted to update you on where we are. The organization to make a decision on my sabbatical is called the Eli Lilly Foundation. Through their endowments, they offer financial gifts for philanthropic and religious purposes like this.



They have my application. A decision will be made by the end of August this year. If I'm approved, I hope to walk on what's called the Via Francigena. It's a medieval pilgrimage from Canterbury, England to Rome, Italy. Leaders at BAUMC felt it best if I'd break up my sabbatical over two years. I agreed with them. The total time for me to walk the route should be about four months. I've added some family time at the beginning of my trip. If it happens, it will be in the summers of 2025 and 2026.

I want to thank you for all of your encouragement. It's been inspiring to hear so many of you get excited for this possibility. I'd like to think that it's also from God, so I'm praying that it will happen. Thank God that I've been healthy enough to go. If I don't get approved, or if it doesn't happen for any reason, I'll be ok.

BAUMC High School Graduating Senior Scholarship

The Bel Air United Methodist Church Involvement College Scholarship is offered to high school seniors who are members of the church and who will be entering the first year of college in Fall 2024. Scholarship applications are reviewed and evaluated on three criteria – academic achievement, community and church involvement, and letters of recommendation. This scholarship award began in 1980 through a gift from Ben and Rachel Tobin, and donations from members and friends of BAUMC fund the scholarships awarded each spring.

Pay It Forward Scholarship

The "Pay It Forward Scholarship Endowment" provides funding for individuals seeking education beyond high school. This includes traditional higher education, trade school, apprenticeships, or job training/retraining/certifications.




