Lenten Sermon Series *The Six Days of Creation in Genesis 1*

Lent has Begun!

There are six weeks of Lent. During those six weeks, we're invited to deepen our relationship with the Lord through worship, study, fasting, prayer, sacrifice, meditation, and acts of service and Christian love. Our sermon series and our Tuesday evening study series will be completely different this year. We invite you to try both.

Our sermon series for Lent will focus on Genesis 1, the six days of creation.

- Feb. 26 – Day 1 – Light
- March 5 – Day 2 – Sea & Sky
- March 12 – Day 3 – Land
- March 19 – Day 4 – Sun & Moon
- March 26 – Day 5 – Sea Creatures & Sky Creatures
- April 2 – Day 6 – Land Creatures
- April 9 – Day 7 – Easter Sunday - Jesus, Lord of All Creation

You'll find the six days of creation in Genesis 1 – Genesis 2:4a. After that, the Bible shifts to tell a wonderfully different account of creation featuring Adam and Eve. To compliment this creation series, our Creation Care Team will be hosting a variety of activities to highlight the various ways that we can care for God's good creation. Please join us each Sunday for this exciting series.

On Tuesday evenings, come join us for Soup & Study, 5:30-7:00 pm. Join us in McComas Hall for a modest, but delicious soup dinner. Then stay for the study based on the book, "Savior: What the Bible Says About the Cross," by Magrey R. DeVega. 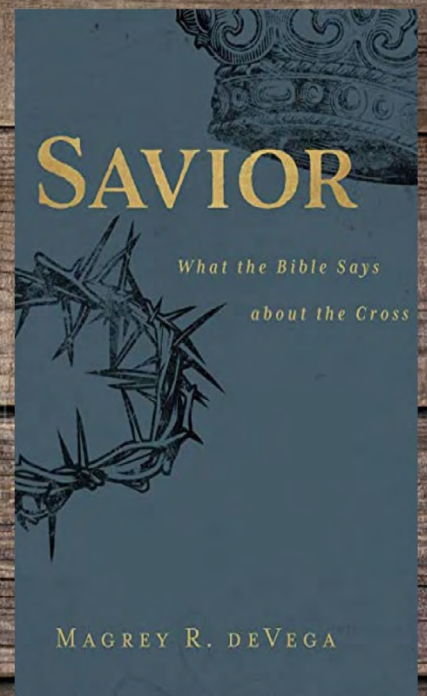

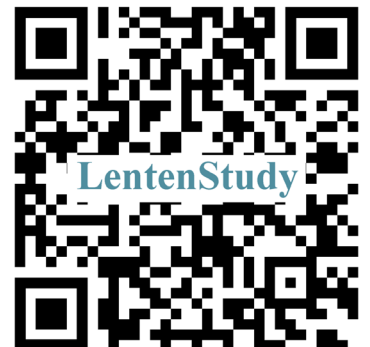

The home was a duplex and one of three built by Habitat in Havre de Grace. Our church was a sponsor of the build with our congregation providing \$10K in donations. The home will be owned by Juel, along with her teenage son, paying an affordable mortgage to repay Habitat.

The dedication had about 40 attendees along with a WMAR 2 news crew. Pastor Byron gave the opening prayer and blessed the house. Randy received the BAUMC sponsorship certificate for the church. The Habitat staff said they are blessed to have BAUMC as part of their faith. Habitat/VIM will be doing another Habitat panel build in June.
