

CITY OF OZARK CITYWIDE CLEAN-UP

Saturday, April 13th, 2019

Please read through this information carefully to ensure you meet the guidelines of this program!

The citywide clean-up is Saturday, April 13th, 2019 and is **only** for residents inside the City of Ozark paying for Trash Services through the City of Ozark water. This program is being offered with the intent to provide the opportunity to dispose of large items and get rid of old, worn-out household items. It is **not** intended for remodel projects or residents outside the city.

CURBSIDE PICK-UP

- * Citizens must have their acceptable items at the curb no later than 6:00 a.m. on the morning of Saturday, April 13th, for pick-up. They are also encouraged to put items out the night before as multiple trucks will be running.
- * Any **non-acceptable** items will be left at the curb for disposal by the resident. We will not pick up remodel projects.
- * Crews cannot access personal property including trailers or assist in moving items to the curb.
- * Clean-up **will not** take place at businesses, apartment buildings or at vacant homes.
- * **NO CONSTRUCTION or REMODEL PROJECTS**

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Furniture – Indoor/Outdoor*
- No more than two (2) large furniture items* - Sofa, chair, table, television stand
- Microwaves
- Pallets
- Hand and Power Tools
- Basketball Goals (Must be broken down to 5' ft. lengths)
- Televisions/Monitors – 1 per household
- Bicycles
- Beds/Mattresses
- Carpeting/Padding (Must be cut in 4' or smaller sections)
- Weed Eaters (Must be drained of all fuel and oil)
- Appliance – \$15.00 Charge

\$15.00 charge for appliances and resident must contact Republic Services at 417-268-1265 by April 9th, 2019 to request and make payment prior to pick up. These appliances include: Washer, Dryer, Stove, Hot Water Heater; *Refrigerators/Freezers must have Freon removed and properly tagged** by a certified specialist. If not properly tagged, the item will not be picked up.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- Tires
- More than 2 large furniture items
- Items over 6' ft. length
- Appliances with Freon that is not properly tagged
- Construction or Large Remodeling (this includes decks and outbuildings)
- Rocks, bricks, concrete
- Hazardous Waste (including paint, oil, aerosol cans, fertilizers, etc.)
- Brush/Limbs/Yard Waste
- Propane Tanks
- Batteries
- No Vehicle Parts (Motors, Doors, Hoods, etc.)
