




The Idaho Transportation Department is planning to improve State Highway 75 between McKercher Boulevard and Timber Way, and between Birch Street and Fox Acres Road.

Plans include improvements to the Gannett Road intersection and multimodal improvements at the Broadway Run intersection.

This project includes the environmental and roadway design work that will be necessary to:

- Widen SH-75 between McKercher Boulevard and Timber Way, and between Birch Street and Fox Acres Road.
- Improve several intersections along SH-75.
- Add multimodal infrastructure for pedestrians, cyclists and transit users.



Process and Schedule

2008	ITD completed the SH-75 Timmerman to Ketchum Environmental Impact Statement. This document involved eight years of in-depth environmental review and public outreach.
2009 – 2019	ITD completed two major projects along this area of SH-75: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reconstruction & widening of SH-75 from Timber Way to Big Wood River Bridge (2012)• Reconstruction of the Big Wood River Bridge near Elkhorn Road (2016)
2019	ITD began an environmental reevaluation for a third project between Elkhorn Road and River Street. Development of this project is expected to be completed in 2024. Construction could begin in 2025 or 2026.
2021	Work began on an environmental reevaluation of highway improvements between Bellevue and Broadway Run.
NOV. 2022	ITD hosted a public meeting to gather public input on preliminary design plans.
JAN. 2024	ITD is gathering community input on updated design plans between Bellevue and Broadway Run. 
2024	Final design plans will be completed and right-of-way purchases will begin.
2025	Construction could begin as early as 2025.
