“I was the first employee hired by Sparky Clark to work at Crater Community Hospice when we were “first born.” We weren’t even licensed at that point and we had no policies, procedures or bookkeeping system in place. We literally built this organization from scratch. My very first day on the job I went shopping for start-up office supplies. Then we hired a Volunteer Coordinator, a Social Worker, and finally a Nurse. It was a long process from May until August when we were finally issued a license to admit our first patient.”

“Back in the early days, things were often very tight financially and sometimes we couldn’t make payroll, even with only 5 employees. The two hospitals kept us going until we could stand on our own and look at us today! All thanks to this community we serve and to the staff and volunteers who work so hard to keep us growing and Celebrating Life Every Day!”
