Each year hundreds of volunteers come together to serve lobster rolls, fry clams, manage parking, and keep the grounds clean to raise funds for more than 35 local nonprofits, clubs, churches, and school groups. Enjoy live entertainment, browse craft booths, enter competitions, buy a T-shirt, or simply savor a clam — every purchase and every hour you spend supports our community. Thank you for making a difference!

Getting to the Festival

Parking: Paid lots near the Festival center benefit local nonprofit groups. (See detailed map inside or visit clamfestival.com.) Accessible parking at Festival Center is offered at North Yarmouth Academy, InterMed, Hancock Lumber and First Universalist Church. Please see parking attendants for assistance.

Free Public Shuttle: Park at I-295's Yarmouth Exit 15 Park-N-Ride and take the bus into Festival Center all weekend long! Shuttle buses run from 9am-10:30pm Fri & Sat, and 9am-5pm Sun. **No shuttle Friday 5-7pm**, and buses will run more slowly during these heavy traffic times: Fri 8-10:30pm, Sat 11am-1pm and Sat 9:30-10:30pm. Thanks to our shuttle sponsor, Yarmouth Audiology. The bus stop is located in front of their office at 163 Main Street (near the NYA info booth).

Biking: Free Bike Corral located on Cleaves Street near the Food Circle at Memorial Green.

Walking: Please use the Beth Condon Pathway along Route 1.

Metro BREEZ: Paid bus service runs to and from Yarmouth, Freeport, Brunswick and Portland. There will be two stops on Route 1 with easy walking access to the festival. Metro BREEZ will not stop on Main Street during the Clam Festival.

Road Closures

Several streets surrounding the Festival Center will be closed to vehicles during the weekend, although delivery, vendor and resident traffic will be allowed. Visit clamfestival.com for all road closures and weekend detours.

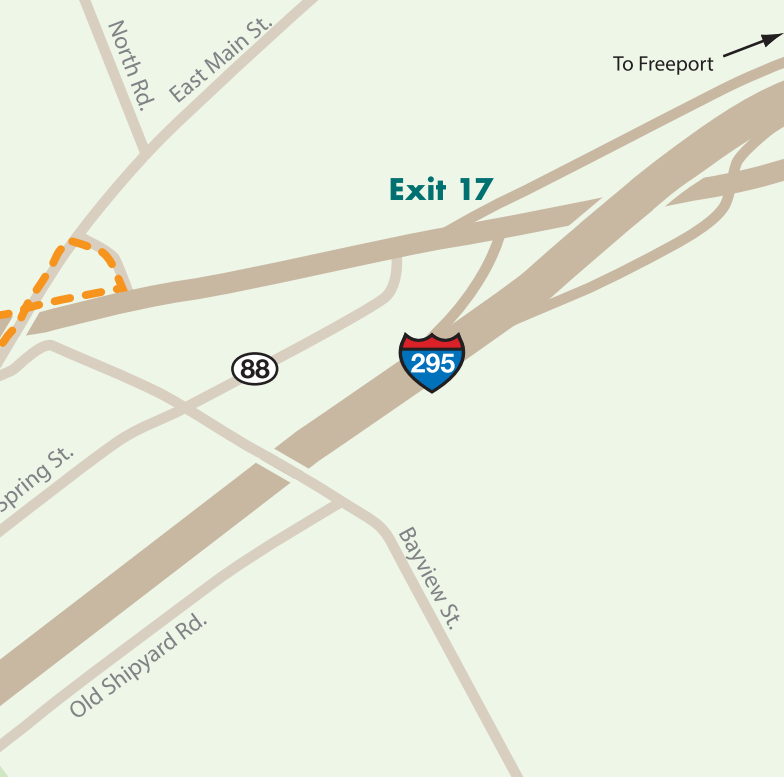
SHUTTLE

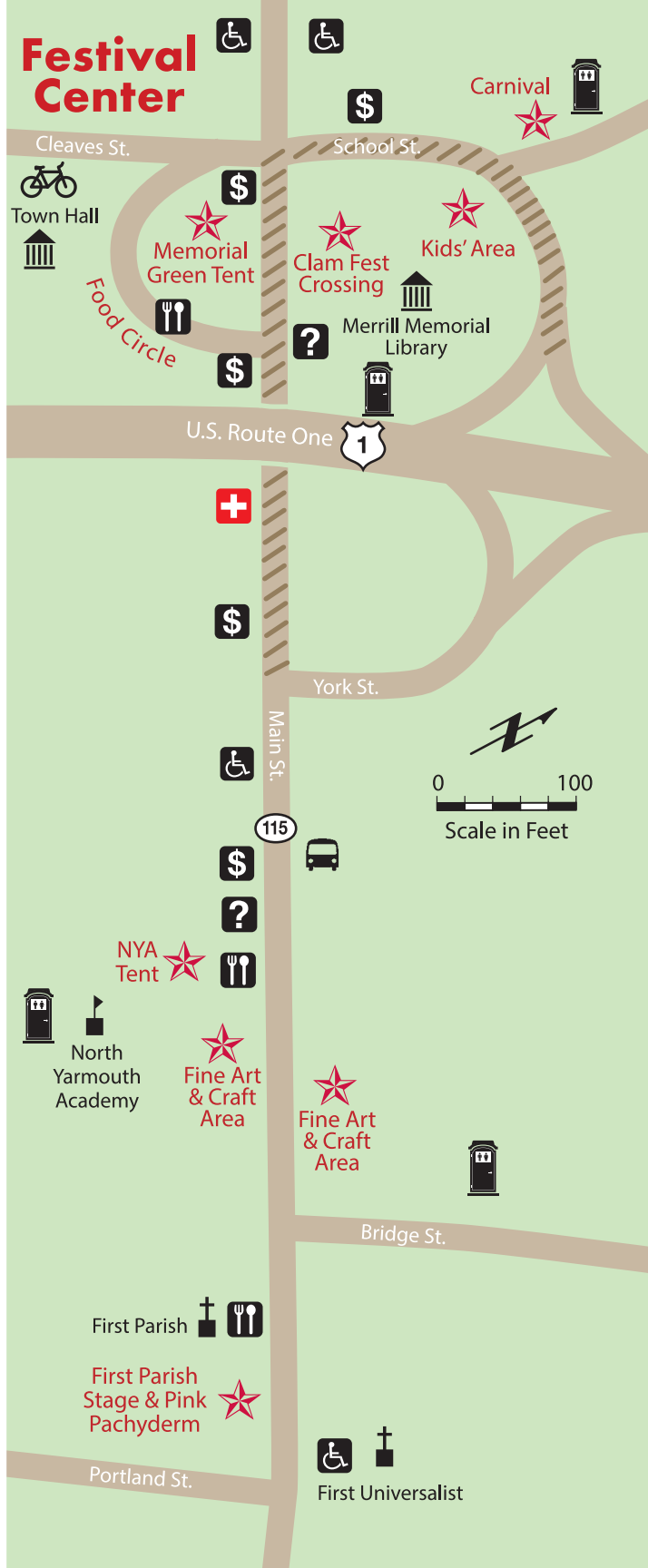

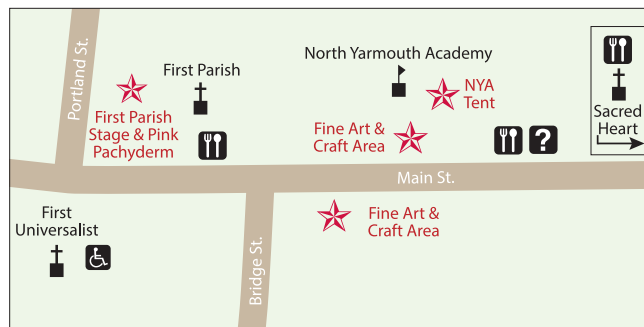

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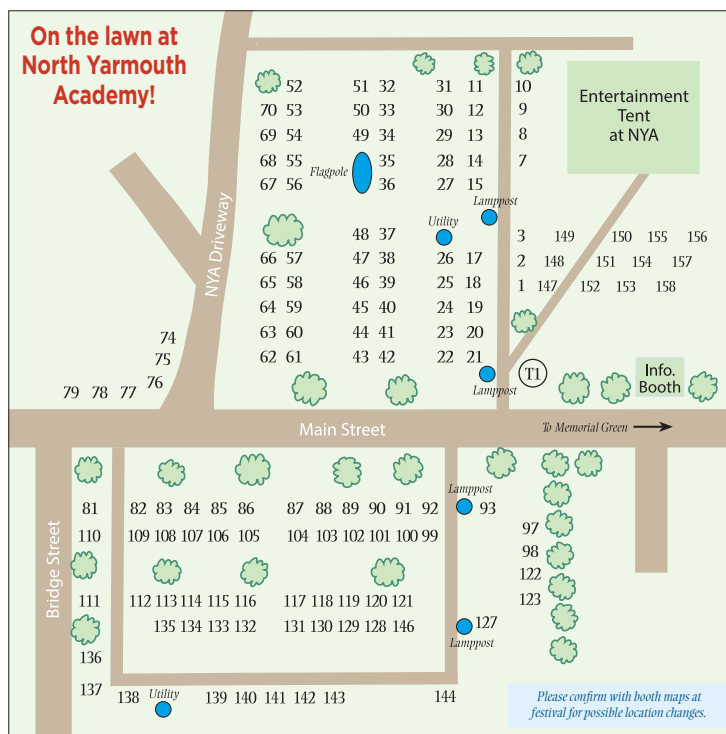
