Welcome back to the monthly newsletter!

We took a small hiatus due to the pandemic. It is hard to believe that it has been six months. And while we have been unable to gather together for worship, a great deal of ministering has been going on. Indeed, the rhythm of our life together is different, but we have adapted some of our old activities and invented some new ones, to enrich our own lives and those of the greater

community. Evening and Morning Prayer services complement our Sunday livestream. The Prayer Shawl Ministry group continues to meet and deliver prayer shawls. Ed Happ and Ralph Nazareth host Poetry Slams. A joyful noise is made with Zoom Sing-alongs. Michele Beudert has masterfully kept Godly Play going with her personal, weekly mailings to the kids. Miles for a Mission had its most successful race, bringing in over \$38,000 for Equal Justice Initiative. We joined in on a Habitat for Humanity Work Day. And there is more. While we are not physically together, the spirit of St. Francis—loving, giving, pardoning—is alive and well. Thank you for your part in our life together, and I hope to see you soon.

The following is from a letter that we just sent to the parish:

As we near Rally Sunday and the start of the program year at St. Francis on September 13, I hope that this note finds you well, and blessings on you all now and always. I write to alert you to a few important items and events in our life together.

First and foremost, please understand we will not hold in-person worship at this time. While some churches have returned to their buildings, the wardens, vestry, and I, following the guidance of our bishops and others, feel that the risk of a possible infection is still too great. Our concern is for the safety of all members. It would be unconscionable for anyone to get sick due to our actions. Thus, we will continue with our Sunday livestream for the foreseeable future. Thank you for your patience in this difficult time.
