STAYING INFORMED

FOLLOWING PHASE 2 GUIDELINES

Metro Christian Academy is currently following Phase 2 Oklahoma Guidelines adapted for Metro which include personnel checking-in when entering the campus with standardized COVID-19 screening questions and temperature checks. Additionally, the school is minimizing building access to non-essential vendors by utilizing curbside drop-off and deliveries.

EMPLOYING SOCIAL DISTANCING AND SAFETY GUIDELINE PROTOCOLS

Metro Christian Academy and its faculty and staff will adhere and follow all social distancing requirements and guidelines recommended by the CDC and the Tulsa County Health Department, including but not limited to: masks when in common-use areas and/or when the recommended 6'-0" of social distancing cannot be maintained, ensuring hand sanitizer stations at entrances, and stringently disinfecting the building each evening.

IMPLEMENTING ANTI-VIRUS STRATEGIES

Metro Christian Academy is developing and transitioning to long-term anti-virus spreading strategies including, but not limited to: touchless hand sanitizer and soap dispensers, touchless lighting in rooms, as well as, an open-door policy for common interior doors in an effort to lessen common touch points during the school day.
