

IF...

You are feeling ill and your symptoms match those identified for COVID-19



THEN...

Contact the school nurse and your health care provider for further instructions and to see if you should get tested for COVID-19. Stay home until cleared to return to school.

Someone in your household is feeling ill and his or her symptoms match those identified for COVID-19



You may continue to attend school if you feel well and do not have any symptoms. If you become symptomatic or your household member gets tested for COVID-19, you must stay home. Contact the school nurse for more information.

You get tested for COVID-19 because you are symptomatic



Contact the school nurse to report your test and stay home until your test results are returned. All siblings must remain home until the test results are received. If your test returns a **NEGATIVE RESULT**, stay at home until you are symptom-free for 24 hours and feeling well. You may then return to school. Siblings may immediately return to school.

If you receive a **POSITIVE RESULT**, you must begin quarantining. Please report your test result to the school nurse. All siblings are considered close contacts and are required to quarantine.

You get tested for COVID-19 because you have been exposed to an individual who has tested positive



Contact the school nurse to report your test and stay home until your test results are returned. All siblings must remain home until the test results are received. If your test returns a **NEGATIVE RESULT**, you are still considered a close contact and must continue your quarantine until cleared by the Health Department. However, siblings may return to school.

If you receive a **POSITIVE RESULT**, you must continue quarantining. Please report your test result to the school nurse. All siblings are considered close contacts and are required to quarantine.

A member of your household tests positive for COVID-19

OR

you are identified as a close contact of an individual who has tested positive



Contact the school nurse to report the test result. Follow the guidelines for quarantine provided by the Health Department. Your quarantine days will be determined based on information collected by the Health Department during their close contact investigation of the positive case. You may return to school when your quarantine period ends and you are cleared by the Health Department.

If the close contact is not a member of your immediate family, all siblings may still report to school.

You are the sibling or family member of an individual who has been identified as a close contact exposure and required to quarantine



You are not considered a close contact exposure and may continue coming to school. You are not required to quarantine.

You are the sibling or family member of an individual who has been identified as a close contact exposure and that individual tests positive for COVID-19



You are now considered a close contact exposure and are required to quarantine. Report this information to the school nurse. You will be added to virtual learning for all classes and may return to school at the conclusion of your 14 day quarantine after being cleared by the Health Department.
