As a way to encourage Emeritus College members to teach courses in the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute at Emory (OLLI), the Emeritus College is offering EUEC-OLLI Teaching Fellowships. As you know, the Emeritus College already extends research funding in various forms to help advance members' research projects. In this same spirit, we want to support and encourage our members in their teaching.

Here are the rules that apply:

Any member is eligible, whether or not the member has taught in OLLI before.

The proposed course should normally be different from one a member has taught before in OLLI.

The amount of the fellowship award is \$250 per course.

Team-teaching is encouraged; if a team-taught course proposal is accepted, the amount of the fellowship award will be adjusted at the discretion of the Director of the EUEC.

Applications to OLLI are made on an Instructor Proposal Form available on the OLLI web site at [http://ece.emory.edu/olli/Teach\\_at\\_OLLI.html](http://ece.emory.edu/olli/Teach_at_OLLI.html).

Applications for the Fellowship should be sent to [emeriti@emory.edu](mailto:emeriti@emory.edu) and should include:  
the name(s) of the applicant(s);  
a short *curriculum vitae* of the applicant(s);  
a title and short description of the course;  
a brief outline of what will be covered in eight classes of one hour each.

Additionally, a very short cover letter should outline the experiences and interests of the faculty member(s) and how those will contribute to the success of the course. The proposal will be evaluated by the EUEC Teaching and Mentoring Committee.

Those receiving an award will be designated as EUEC-OLLI Teaching Fellows.

Both the Emeritus College and OLLI are eager to see more Emory emeriti take part in this venture, which benefits both the students and teachers, and which creates enormous good will toward the University in the greater Atlanta community. As you know, there are enormous reserves of talent and erudition in the membership of the Emeritus College that too often go unused and unappreciated. It is our hope that you will be willing to share some of your own by becoming an EUEC-OLLI Teaching Fellow.
