LPGA Amateurs Cleveland Chapter New Member Guide

Welcome to the LPGA Amateurs Cleveland Chapter and the LPGA Amateur Golf Association family! Here is some useful information and references to help get you oriented. It's a lot to absorb, so once you've skimmed this packet, keep it handy for reference.

MEMBERSHIP:

You are affiliated with the Cleveland OH Chapter, but you have joined a national organization - the LPGA Amateur Golf Association - which we often refer to as "HQ."

- Take a minute to log in to the HQ **Member Clubhouse** (<u>https://lpgaamateurs.com</u>), where you can update your profile, access HQ benefits and special offers, and more. (*You established your login when you joined - username is your email; password is something you set*).
- Note that you'll be required to be logged in to HQ's Member Clubhouse in order to access certain information, register for some events and activities and renew your membership.

COMMUNICATIONS:

The Cleveland chapter updates members on local events via periodic e-mails from *Cleveland LPGA Amateurs*. E-newsletters include upcoming events and registration links, news from our chapter President, and other important information. Please include our email address, **Ipgaamateurscleveland@gmail.com** in your email address book so that our emails will not go to spam. You can also see information posted on our Facebook page and LinkedIn pages. You may opt out of chapter emails through the link at the bottom of each email, however you will miss all local events, activities, and league announcements.

You will also receive periodic emails from *LPGA Amateur Golf Association* and other branches of the LPGA family. These emails will provide information on national events, recognition, member discounts, frequently asked questions and other important information. You can manage how many/which types of these emails you receive from your account in the HQ Member Clubhouse. Links you should know:

LEAGUES:

Offered April through early September, league play is one of the most popular ways to participate. Seven 9-hole leagues at courses around the city have late afternoon start times. Leagues are run by Course Directors who send weekly emails for sign-up for upcoming league

days. Leagues are pay at the course. Check our web site for Course Director contact info and ask to be included in their emails, or contact them prior to league day for sign up. There are games of the week with chances to win prizes (some games require a current handicap to win prizes). You must have a current membership to play in a league.

EVENTS:

Our Chapter events typically include:

- A kickoff event usually in March/April
- 9 hole after work golf leagues
- 18 hole weekend golf at various courses
- Social/Competitive golf events

- Skills and learning opportunities
- Weekend travel golf opportunities
- Networking and social events
- Volunteer opportunities

Detailed information (and links to registration) for all events are available on our website as soon as it's available during the golf season. Check your email blasts to keep informed about upcoming events.

OPEN WEEKEND GOLF :

Offered typically May through September, Open Weekend Golf are once-a-month 18 hole recreational rounds played on Saturdays or Sundays at courses around the city. Weekend may include overnight weekend golf opportunities. ANY member is welcome to play and may bring a guest. Pay at the course. RSVP sign-up notifications are in email blasts.

COMPETITIVE EVENTS:

There are Chapter competitive flighted golf events held on weekend dates during the golf season, so no matter what your handicap is, you can participate! At the national level, there are LPGA Amateur events open to members which include:

- LPGA Amateurs Scramble Open. A net 36-hole national scramble event with 4 player teams.
- LPGA Amateurs Championship. This is an individual flighted stroke play competition.
- LPGA Amateurs Team Championship. This two-person team event features two different stroke play formats over 36 holes, fourball and alternate shot.
- LPGA Amateurs Cup Series. This is a match play competition involving eight-member teams. Competition begins with regional qualifying competitions, with winners advancing to the national Cup Final.
- LPGA Amateurs Virtual Scramble. A fund raiser competition where you create your own team of four LPGA Amateurs and play a 4-person scramble at any Par 72 course of your choice.

HANDICAPS:

All members of LPGA Amateurs Cleveland are eligible to sign-up for a GHIN handicap provided for us through the Northeast Ohio Golf Association (NOGA). For more information on handicapping, and to sign up for a GHIN handicap, <u>click here</u>.

Handicaps are not required for all golf, but are for competitive events. Our chapter members who have an active GHIN handicap through the Cleveland LPGA Amateurs Chapter receive additional benefits from the Northeast Ohio Golf Association (NOGA), including golfing opportunities.
