The Bright Program, a community day service program serving adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities, recently moved to 1110 N. Main Street in Algonquin, IL. The program focuses on community integration through daily trips into the community. This new facility allows easier access to a wide variety of activities in the community.

The daily community trips teach skills that help our clients navigate independently, pay for goods and services and engage in meaningful and engaging activities. There is also a focus on serving the community through various volunteering projects and partnerships with other charitable organizations.

Participants in the program also engage in opportunities to increase their own physical health through healthy meal preparation classes and weekly fitness classes in partnership with Northwestern Medicine.

“Our clients increase their independence by practicing activities of daily living and social skills,” explains Bright Program Supervisor, Jeremy Penze.
