Leadership; Becoming a Multiple Intelligences School; and School Leadership for the Future. He has written more than 185 articles, and his "Principal Connection" column was published in Educational Leadership 2004-2018. He wrote a leadership blog for ASCD from 2021-2023.

He holds a Ph.D. from Washington University in St. Louis and has received honorary doctorates from two universities. Dr. Hoerr founded and directed the Non-Profit Management Program at Washington University, led the ISACS New Heads Network, and is the Emeritus Head of the New City School.
