### [UPDATED GUIDANCE](#)

Guidance applies to registered work-based learning programs (CEIP, Co-op, GEWEP and WECEP)

Local discretion can be used in waiving some or all the work-based learning hours in the four registered programs, as well as locally determined requirements in NYSED-approved CTE programs, if the student attained CDOS standards 1, 2 and 3a at commencement level.
