



Education Advisory Committee

Rhode Island PBS Education Services Department is seeking PreK-12 educators to serve on our Education Advisory Committee to help guide development and distribution of instructional media content and resources to Rhode Island educators, students, and parents. We are hoping to add approximately three to five educators to the Committee, representing a range of grade levels and subject areas, all with particular interest in use of instructional media and technology. Participation is on a volunteer basis. Responsibilities include:

- Providing advisory support on the development of media-based instructional resources, outreach initiatives, and professional development services.
- Ensuring Rhode Island PBS Education Services support high-need and diverse students and their educators.
- Providing communications support for Rhode Island PBS resources by sharing information with stakeholder networks.
- Attendance and/or participation in quarterly 90-minute meetings (at most 4 per calendar year), with some email communication between. Meetings are held either early morning (8:00-9:30 am) or after school (4:00-5:30 pm) to minimize impact on school hours. Meetings take place at Rhode Island PBS offices, 50 Park Lane, Providence (free dedicated parking lot onsite for easy access)—in-person attendance preferred, but remote participation via conference call or online meeting available as needed.
- 3-year term, rotating to ensure input from schools/districts across the state over the long-term
