- Identify an adult to be the renewal processor for Internet Rechartering.
- Make sure all your adult leaders have completed their required training. Remember, Mount Baker Council's youth protection training is required each year.
- Identify opportunities for leaders to complete required training by using the *Mountain Echo* newsletter and the Council Website. The University of Scouting on Saturday, October 28th in Arlington is an excellent "last chance" training opportunity.
- Obtain the charter renewal packet for your unit at your October District Roundtable. See your district calendar for dates and locations. Like prior years, each packet will have detailed instructions for how to complete Internet Recharter and will include notice of your District Recharter Turn-In Night.
- Review your unit's *Journey to Excellence* progress and begin planning for improvement in 2018!
