## Join Us at the 24<sup>th</sup> World Scout Jamboree

The 2019 World Scout Jamboree is the largest camping event organized by the World Organization of the Scout Movement, gathering 50,000 Scouts and leaders from 169 National Scout Organizations. The 24th World Scout Jamboree (WSJ) is co-hosted by Scouts Canada, Association de Scouts de Mexico and the Boy Scouts of America. The last time the United States hosted a WSJ was in 1967 in Idaho.

The World Jamboree is an event that brings together young men and young women from around the world to promote peace, mutual understanding, and to develop leadership skills. The Jamboree will feature the hallmarks of past World Jamboree programs, such as the Global Development Village, the World Scout Centre, a special sustainability initiative, and the socialization elements that allow participants to make lifelong friends from around the world.

**Dates:** July 21 – August 2, 2019

**Location:** Summit Bechtel Scout Reserve, West Virginia

**Eligibility:** Birthday between July 22, 2001 and July 21, 2005, both boys and girls

**Cost:** \$2800. Scholarships based on need are available, but the application deadline is this July, 2018.
