



BALOO TRAINING

Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation



BALOO is REQUIRED TRAINING for all Cub Scout Packs that would like to do Overnight Camping as a part of their Pack activities. A minimum of one adult must be BALOO Trained on a Pack overnighiter.

BALOO now consists of two components: on-line and hands-on. You'll need to complete both - in order - to qualify as a "Trained" Cub Scout outdoor leader.

1. **On-line component:** The on-line portion of BALOO is available 24/7 on the BSA Learn Center. It contains introductory and basic information that will be built upon during the practical training. This training can be done through your my.scouting.org training account. Once logged on to your my.scouting.org, go to: **My Dashboard**; then **My Training**; then **Training Center**; then **Expanded Learning (includes Hazardous Weather)**; then **BALOO**. Please complete all the BALOO Prerequisite Training modules prior to your arrival at camp.

The goal of the on-line portion is to make the best use of time to allow leaders to experience as much as possible during the practical hands-on training.

2. **Practical, hands-on component:** This 1.5-day course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for leaders interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities. This is an energetic training that will cover everything you need to know to plan and run a pack overnighiter. It is more than just camping - it includes ideas for outdoor activities, games and ceremonies; information on selecting and using camping equipment; how to run a campfire program; and hands-on Cub Scout cooking demonstrations!

Cost: \$25 Please eat before arriving at camp on Friday night (no evening meal will be offered). Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided on Saturday.
