National Camp School is first and foremost designed to train key seasonal camp leadership. However, volunteers currently involved in or a desire to support council programs are also encouraged to attend, with Council approval.

The course catalog includes certification courses for Camp Director, Program Director, Aquatics, COPE, Climbing, Ecology/Conservation, Outdoor Skills and Shooting Sports. You have to be a registered volunteer with current Youth Protection training and at least 18 years of age. You have to attend all sessions to be considered for certification, along with required prerequisites and successful completion of skilled-based activities.
