Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills



This 1.5-day, overnight training course will give you the hands on practical outdoor skills needed to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. You will learn how to **teach** Scouts the skills they must learn through First Class and includes such areas as wood tools, fire site preparation and building, packing and hiking techniques, ropes, cooking, plant and animal identification, and campfire program.

This is **required** training for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters. This is recommended training for Venturing Advisors and Assistant Venturing Advisors if your crew has an outdoor program.
