



# Friends of the NRA Foundation Grant awarded for new Fire Mountain Armory

If you are up at Fire Mountain this summer you may see some work going on at the south side of the new parking lot. The Council is building a new storage and workshop area for our program suppliers and a place for our camp ranger work. As part of this new building the Properties Committee has agreed to include space for a camp armory. The new armory is being designed to BSA specifications and will be environmentally controlled so that our firearms and shooting sports equipment can be maintained as they should be. The new armory will also include a lighted work area so that we will now have a safe and convienient place to clean and maintain our equipment.

The Friends of the NRA Foundation has awarded the Mount Baker Council over \$3,500 to help defray the cost of the new armory. The money will be used for a steel wall and for storage lockers inside the new space. Because of this grant the new armory at Fire Mountain will be a great addition to our camp.
