National Youth Leadership Training exciting, action packed program designed to provide youth members of the Boy Scouts of America with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home Troops, Varsity Teams and Venturing Crews. The leadership skills taught can be used in any other situation demanding leadership of "self" and "others."

This process begins with a "vision" of what success will look like in the future.

Scouting recognizes that Scoutmasters, Coaches, and Advisors have the primary responsibility for training their youth leaders. The purpose of NYLT is not to assume that role, but rather to support it. NYLT features instruction in skills that can be used at home, at school, on the job, and, in particular, at the Scout unit level. Through activities, presentations, challenges, discussions, along with audio-visual support, NYLT participants will work hard and play hard together as they put into action the best Scouting has to offer.

"If You Can See It, You Can Be It"

Overview of The Course

The course models a month in the life of a Unit. Three Course meetings (one each day for the first three days) lead up to a big outdoor experience (an overnight outpost camp). The course uses the team method. There is a Leader's Council meeting each day of the course.

Teams are challenged early in the week to present to the group at the end of the week their "Quest for the Meaning of Leadership." While the challenge is designed to have them go through the four stages of team development, it will help teams and individual Scouts internalize the leadership skills and concepts being presented to them along the way.

Throughout the course, the staff will be modeling the concepts and skills that are the core content of the course. The focus of each session is not only knowledge but giving the Scout a "Toolbox of Skills" that equips them with the "how."

Who, When, Where, and Cost

Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts, and Venturing Crew members open to males and female. Boy Scouts must be 13 years old and 1st class with Scoutmaster recommendation. Venturing Scouts 14 – 20 years old with Advisor recommendation. The courses for 2017 are Monday August 14-19 or Monday August 21-26 and will be held at Fire Mountain Scout Camp.

The cost is \$240 if medical form and full payment accompanying the application by June 30th. Then, the fee is \$290 within 30 days prior to course.
