Work sites will be assigned on a first come-first served basis.

- A Pilchuck Trailhead**
- 1) Pick up litter in parking lot and along the trail
 - 2) Weed the planter bed
 - 3) Cut back any blackberries, wild cucumber, or other shrubbery that is encroaching on the trail.
 - 4) Spread gravel on the trail north of the kiosk (bring a few wheelbarrows)
- B Centennial Middle School**
- 1) Pick up litter along the trail
 - 2) Cut back blackberries along the horse trail.
- C Machias Trailhead**
- 1) Pick up Litter in parking lot and along the trail
 - 2) Weed Flower bed
 - 3) Pickup sticks / branches in grass area
 - 4) Fill in potholes with gravel (bring a few wheelbarrows)
- D Horse Trail North of Machias Trailhead**
- 1) Pick up trash along trail
 - 2) Cut back blackberries along horse trail
- E SR 92 trailhead**
- 1) Pick up trash along the trail
 - 2) Paint underpass supports a stone gray (cover graffiti)
 - 3) Cut back brush and blackberries near parking area and along trail



Please bring: heavy gloves, loppers, shears, shovels, garbage bags, wheelbarrows. **NO machetes or power tools.**

Removing blackberry sprouts are the major need at B and D above are the major needs
