CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS UPDATE

Your Mount Baker Council Properties Committee has been very busy over the winter months...

1. We have completed the entire camp water system replacement. A huge and important project that gets buried, and nobody can see. It will serve us well for generations to come.
2. We have completed the new Ranger's Shop/Storage building, except for exterior paint (see pictures below).



3. After burning down the old farmhouse and hauling off debris, we then demolished the old Skagit Shelter and the old Bell Tower (we kept the bell). Both had rotting posts and needed to be removed sooner than later. The new Janicki Shelter will replace the old Skagit Shelter. After all the demolition work, the upper assembly field was lowered an average of three feet (see pictures below).



4. We started construction of the new M & E Turner and Family General Store. The foundation is complete, and construction should be completed by the end of May (see pictures below).



5. Last but not least, we have put in for permits for our new Janicki Shelter. This post and beam constructed structure will be complete in time for summer camp 2020.

There are numerous other smaller projects that have been done or will be done before summer camp as well. These projects keep us moving toward our goal of having one of the best Scout Summer Camps in the United States.
