assumes basic backpacking knowledge and builds on that for a fun and safe experience in the Winter.

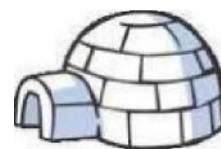


More ...

The Winter Skills Adventure program has two parts: a full day classroom session where you'll learn the necessary skills, and then a weekend field trip where you'll put those skills to the test by building a snow structure & then you'll spend the night in it!

To participate, scouts must be at least 14 years old. This is a requirement due to the heavy lifting of snow blocks, the challenging work and extreme conditions the scouts will encounter.

The class welcomes and encourages older scouts to assist as junior leaders.
