Greetings to all Scout leaders! We are looking forward to next year's Klondike Derby with great anticipation. Klondike 2018 will be held at Ensign Ranch, Cle Elum, Washington on Saturday, February 3, 2018

Weather reports are promising for us to have snow. We know that you will know how to prepare "snow or shine"!

All participating units that wish to stay over Friday and/or Saturday night will have to register at the Mount Baker Council Office and make the appropriate reservations via this form BEFORE DECEMBER 14th, 2017. Any non-LDS chartered unit wishing to stay overnight on Saturday night will need to have an adult Latter-day Saint member staying with them. The Ensign Ranch is owned and operated by the LDS Church.

Cost: The participation fee for this year will be \$13.00 per person. (includes Friday night/Saturday day use, lunch, patches and awards). \$17.00 if you plan on staying over on Saturday night.

Lodging: All facilities will be reserved on a first come reservation basis:
The Lodge will require a minimum of sixteen (16) persons
Cabins 1, 2 & 3 will require a minimum of three (3) persons
Cabins 4 & 5 will require a minimum of four (4) persons
Cabins 6, 7 ,8, 9, 10 & 11 will require a minimum of five (5) persons.
The Lodge and Cabin rentals will include the day use fee for Friday evening and Saturday.
