



## Redwood Christian Schools Daily Student Health Screening Protocol Questionnaire

*The current employee, volunteer, and visitor daily health screening consists of three questions: (this is based upon the [Alameda County Public Health Department COVID-19 Screening Guidance for Businesses and Organizations](#) daily screening required for employees of open businesses):*

### Tested – Close Contact – Symptoms

1. Within the last 10 days have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 or had a test confirming you have the virus?

- Yes - Do Not Come to School, contact your principal to request a substitute.
- No - Continue to question #2.

2. Do you live in the same household with, or have you had \*close contact\* in the past 14 days with someone who has been in isolation for COVID-19 or had a test confirming they have the virus? *“Close contact” is defined as living in the same house, being an intimate partner, being a caregiver, or being within 6 feet of an individual for longer than 15 minutes who has COVID-19.*

- Yes - Do Not Come to School, contact your principal to request a substitute.
- No - Continue to question #3.

2. Have you had any one or more of these symptoms today or within the past 24 hours, which is new or not explained by a reason other than possibly having COVID-19?

- Fever, chills, or repeated shaking/shivering
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath, difficulty breathing
- Feeling unusually weak or fatigued
- Loss of taste or smell
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Runny or congested nose
- Diarrhea
- Nausea and vomiting
