



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

GENERAL

Q. Will the KCA Convention be held in-person this year?

Yes, but Convention will only be one-day – Friday, January 15th, 2021. It will still be held at the Owensboro Convention Center. Hotel blocks can be found online at kycattle.org/convention-html.

Q. Will there be a limit to the number of people that can attend Convention?

A. The Owensboro Convention Center has notified us that we are allowed no more than 580 total attendees at this year's convention.

Q. Who will be able to attend?

A. Registration is currently open for any KCA Delegates until December 1st. Starting December 1st, registration will be opened to our general membership until December 15th. All registration opportunities will close at the end of the day on December 15th.

Q. What will be expected if I attend in-person?

A. Attendees will be required to wear a mask in all public areas of the convention center. We also ask that our attendees maintain six feet of social distance between them and another person, wash your hands frequently or use hand sanitizer, and stay home if you have any symptoms of Covid-19.

Q. Will Convention be recorded so I can watch at home?

A. We will not stream live footage of this year's Convention. Videos of the Opening and Closing Sessions will be available for viewing in the coming weeks after the in-person event on January 15th.

REGISTRATION

Q. What is the registration price?

A. There is one set price for Convention Registration this year. There is no group rate, student rate, etc. The registration price for Convention is \$50.

Q. Can I register on-site?

A. No, there will not be any on-site registration this year. Please register by December 15.

Q. How can I register for Convention?

A. Registration can be completed by visiting www.kycattle.org/convention-html and completing registration online, or by printing off the registration form and sending it in through mail.

Q. I'm a delegate, how do I register?

A. Your County President should have received a packet in the mail with registration information for delegates. Your County Chapter can register all the delegates as a group or individually. The deadline for delegates to register is December 1st.

Q. Will I be refunded my registration fee if the Convention is cancelled?

A. Yes, if we have to cancel Convention completely, we will refund your registration fee. If you do not show up to the in-person event, but you paid for a registration, your registration will NOT be refunded.

EVENTS

Q. Are the Beef Efficiency Conference and Forages Conference being held this year?

A. Yes, but these events will be held virtually earlier and held earlier in the week of Convention. The Beef Efficiency Conference will be held on Tuesday, January 12th and the Forages Conference will be held on Wednesday, January 13.

Q. How do I attend the Beef Efficiency Conference and/or Forages Conference?

A. Further details will be released on registering for the virtual Beef Efficiency Conference and Forages Conference. There will be no cost associated with these events.

Q. Will there be a trade show?

A. No, there will not be a trade show this year so that we can utilize the Exhibit Hall to gather as a group while maintaining a safe, social distance. There are sponsorships available for both the in-person and digital events.

Q. Will there be KJCA events at Convention?

A. No, KJCA will not have any events at Convention. Instead, KJCA will meet at an earlier date for their functions.

Q. Will there be a closing banquet with awards?

A. There will still be awards, but there will not be a closing banquet. The 2021 Hall of Fame Inductions will be held during the Closing Session.
