## **Applications Start Soon**

USDA will soon take applications for the Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP), and agricultural producers will apply through USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA). For more information, visit farmers.gov/CFAP

## **HOW TO PREPARE NOW**

You can start gathering information on your farm's recent sales and inventory, as well as completing eligibility forms at farmers.gov/CFAP

Some of the info you'll need includes:

- Tax Identification Number
- Farming operating structure
- Adjusted Gross Income

If you have worked with FSA previously, much of this information is likely on file.



## HOW TO APPLY ONCE SIGNUP BEGINS

- 1. Call your FSA county office to make an appointment. You can find your local Service Center at farmers.gov/CFAP
- 2. FSA will work with you via phone, email, fax, mail, or online tools to receive and complete your application.
