EVER WONDER WHAT ROLE YOU COULD SERVE AS A MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL AT CAMP!?

1. CLINICIAN

- Collaborate with endocrinologists to follow protocols for the diabetes management of nine campers over the course of a session
- New to Kudzu?! No pressure! You'll serve as a Medical Clinician in Training (MCIT) for your first summer and have a returning volunteer as a mentor!
- QUALIFICATIONS: RN, LPN, NP, RD, Pharm.D, PA, Endocrinology Fellow

4. PEDIATRICIAN

- Evaluate and treat non-diabetes related concerns of campers and staff
- NEEDS: 1 Pediatrician each session

2. MED LODGE STAFF

- Administer non-diabetes related medications, triage acute illness and injury
- QUALIFICATIONS: RN, LPN, NP, PA, pediatric resident
- NEEDS: 7 Med Lodge Staff each session

5. DIETITIAN

- Work with food service manager to ensure carbohydrate counts are accurate
- Verify camper food allergies and extent of reaction with parents upon check-in, check ingredient lists to ensure foods are safe for children with such allergies
- NEEDS: 1 Dietitian each session

3. ENDOCRINOLOGIST

- Review blood glucose logs daily with clinicians and advise on insulin adjustment to best care for each camper
- Take call as assigned for midnight rounds to advise clinicians in the event of a diabetes-related emergency
- NEEDS: 2 Endocrinologists each session
