



HonorHealth Addiction Medicine Fellowship Program

In 2018, as a response to the overwhelming need for addiction services and for trained physicians to treat patients with substance abuse disorder, HonorHealth received accreditation to start the first addiction medicine fellowship in Arizona, in partnership with Community Bridges, Inc.

The fellowship is linked to the HonorHealth Family Medicine Residency program under the leadership of Dr. Cynthia Kegowicz. Dr. Michel Sucher, a highly regarded addiction medicine physician and the chief medical officer for Community Bridges, is the program director. The American Board of Medical Specialties formally recognized Addiction medicine as the newest medical subspecialty in March 2016.

In 2019, the fellowship will continue to train two fellows annually, with the next program start set for July 1, 2019. Applications are now being accepted at [HonorHealth.com](https://www.honorhealth.com) under the Addiction Medicine Fellowship program page.
