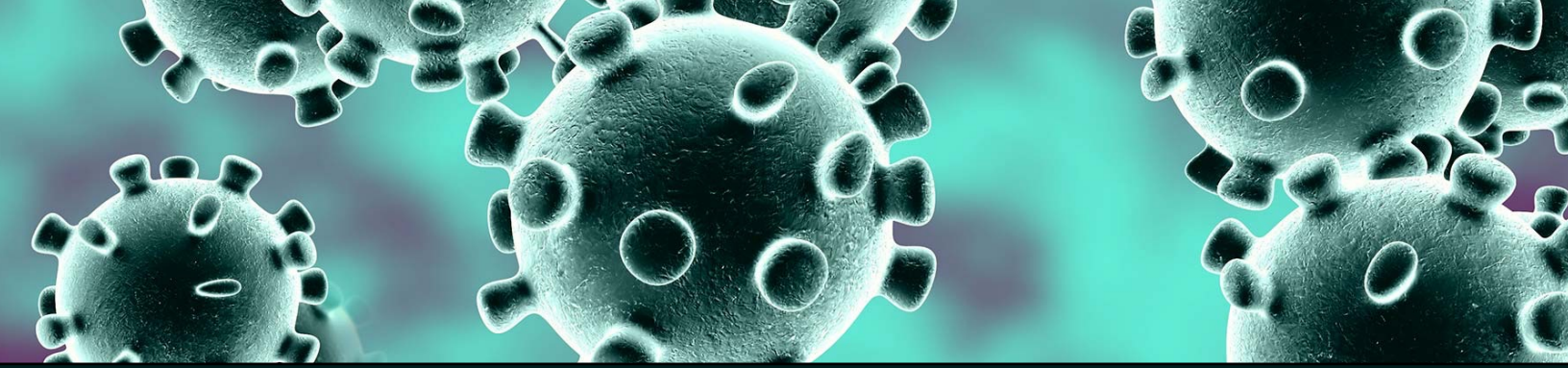
Supporting Partners in Long Term Care
