The In-Person Infant-Toddler Child Development Associate (CDA) class meets at the Child Care Council of Westchester once a week on 2-4 Tuesday evenings from 6-9:30 and three Saturdays. Classes run from September 24, 2019 through June, 2020.

The course fulfills the 120-hour CDA education requirement needed to obtain your CDA. You will also prepare your professional resource file and gather all necessary documents needed to apply to the Council for Professional Recognition to become a CDA.

At the end of the course, students may apply for an EIP scholarship for the \$425 application/assessment fee to the Council for Professional Recognition.

You must have worked 480 hours with infants and/or toddlers in the 3 years before you submit your application.
