

On February 27, 2021 Johnson & Johnson announced that the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has issued Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for its single-dose COVID-19 vaccine, developed by the Janssen Pharmaceutical Companies of Johnson & Johnson, to prevent COVID-19 in individuals 18 years of age and older. On March 8th the updated [Interim Guidelines for fully vaccinated individuals](#) was posted by the CDC. It's important to note that for the purposes of this guidance, people are considered fully vaccinated for COVID-19 ≥ 2 weeks after they have received the second dose in a 2-dose series (Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna), or ≥ 2 weeks after they have received a single-dose vaccine (Johnson and Johnson [J&J]/Janssen).

Starting April 1, [domestic travelers will no longer be required to quarantine](#) after entering New York. While no longer required, quarantine after domestic travel is still advised as added precaution. Mandatory quarantine remains in effect for international travelers as per the [NYS March 11th announcement](#).
