

## TiHAN Update

- We served 110 CarePartners living with HIV
- We distributed 104 CarePackages full of essential personal hygiene and cleaning products
- We handed out 99 Fry's food gift cards, for \$25 each, to eligible CarePartners (those living at 200% or less of the Federal Poverty Level) -- thanks to grant funding and individual donations
- We served 139 meals the day of Poz Café, and a total of 150 meals after distributing the leftover, frozen meals to CarePartners visiting the office in the days after Poz Café
