Please remember our updated Covid-19 safety protocols:

Volunteers and guests are required to wear a KN95 or N95 mask while at our shelter spaces. Eye protection is required for interactions with untested guests, long interactions with guests, or if you are entering a guest's room. Please ask staff for PPE if you need it. All staff and volunteers must eat outdoors. Please do not come volunteer if you are feeling unwell, and remember to get tested weekly even if you are vaccinated.
