We will close out the evening with the Ring Gardner classic short play, "The Tridget of Greva", in which a Corn Vitter, a Wham Salesman, and the Tridget carry on a conversation of non-sequiturs while fishing.

We will learn nothing of sociological, aesthetic, or political import through these plays, but a good time is guaranteed for all.

Scripts will be emailed to all participants – readers and audience - on the Wednesday before the reading, along with the Zoom sign-in information. All are encouraged to attend.
