Miguel A. De La Torre is a professor of [Social Ethics](#) and Latinx Studies at Iliff School of Theology, a scholar-activist, author, and an ordained Southern Baptist minister. De La Torre is considered to be the most published Latinx in the field of religious studies with over thirty books and hundreds of articles. This class will provide an overview of his work on Liberation Theology and on the history and policies of the United States in Central America.
