Are we made in God's image and, if so, what is that? Or do we make God in ours? This class will explore how we conceptualize and experience God and the questions that arise from those conceptions. Is God a superpersonal being with consciousness and agency onto which we have projected human attributes? Or might God be what Paul Tillich calls the "ground of being" or "being itself" and Gordon Kaufman refers to as "serendipitous creativity" underlying all of creation? Join us as we discuss various images and their ramifications for our day-to-day lives.
