

No More Deaths/No Más Muertes

A ministry of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Tucson, No More Deaths/No Mas Muertes works to end death and suffering in the Arizona borderlands. It began in 2004 in the form of a coalition of community and faith groups, dedicated to stepping up efforts to stop the deaths of migrants in the desert and to achieving the enactment of a set of Faith-Based Principles for Immigration Reform. On January of this year, they released a report detailing the U.S. Customs and Border Protection's (CBP) interference with humanitarian aid efforts. A mere few hours after the report release, CBP agents arrested Dr. Scott Warren, one of the volunteers for No More Deaths, and accused him of harboring undocumented immigrants. Dr. Warren is currently indicted on three federal felony charges and faces up to 20 years in prison if convicted. This presentation will offer more information about the work No More Deaths does and how local borderlands residents can show their support.
