Preamble

We prayerfully covenant with one another to:

Love one another

- Love one another and treat others as we want others to treat us. *John 13:34* and *Matthew 7:12*
- Show respect for each other through our words and actions. *Romans 12:10*

Value others and their opinions

- **Encourage** all voices to speak, and recognize that we each bring our own history and experience to any situation. *James 1:19*
- **Listen and ask** questions without judgment and value diverse opinions and ideas. *1 Thessalonians 5:12-13* and *1 Corinthians 12:12*
- **Seek first to understand**, then to be understood—keeping in mind that the Holy Spirit works through all of us. *Proverbs 4:7*, *Acts 2:38*, and *1 Corinthians 12:7*

Support relationships in difficult times

- **Address differences** in a respectful, direct, and caring manner. *Ephesians 4:2-3*
- **Work towards self-control**, practicing the fruits of the spirit. *James 1:18-20* and *Galatians 5:22-23*
- **Agree to disagree** without being disagreeable, keeping our minds on what is true, right, holy, friendly, and proper. *Isaiah 41:10*, *Romans 8:28*, and *Philippians 4:8*

Work together for the good of the Church

- **Work to discover** what is best for our congregation as a whole, rather than what may be best for ourselves or for a select group in the church. *Philippians 2:3-6*
- **Believe the best** of others and give others the benefit of the doubt. *1 Corinthians 13:7*
