

Vera Taylor Scholarship Applications

It's time for scholarship applications. Is someone in your family applying for advanced study at a university or trade school?

Each year, the Vera Taylor Scholarship Committee at Peace United awards scholarships to members who meet the eligibility criteria and submit their applications for review no later than **July 15, 2022**.

Grants are awarded for full-time students in community college, four-year colleges, graduate schools, and trade schools. Mini grants are available for professional development and seminars related to our church mission with funding up to \$450, based on a 50% contribution to the total cost).

The eligibility requirements are:

- 1) Any person who has been an active and supporting member of Peace United for at least one year preceding the application.
- 2) There is no age limit.
- 3) Scholarships are for one year, with half the award paid in August and February.
- 4) Applicants must maintain a 3.0 GPA during the term of the award and must provide a transcript documenting their GPA.
- 5) Demonstration of a financial need is not required.

Application requirements:

- 1) Completed application form submitted by July 15, 2022.
- 2) Most recent transcript from the current year
- 3) Proof of admission (first-time applicants)
- 4) A letter to the committee describing educational plans and career goals
- 5) Digital photograph in JPG or PNG
- 6) One-paragraph summary of goals, interests, and hobbies, suitable for publication in the E News.
