Child psychiatrist Joshua Sparrow, MD, DFAACAP, is director of the Brazelton Touchpoints Center in the Division of Developmental Medicine at Boston Children's Hospital, where he also holds an appointment in the Department of Psychiatry. He is principal investigator for the National Center on Parent, Family, and Community Engagement (Office of Head Start, Office of Child Care, ACF, HHS), and is part-time associate professor in psychiatry at Harvard Medical School. Dr. Sparrow, co-author of nine books on children's development, and hundreds of articles on related topics for academic and general audiences, has lectured extensively nationally and internationally, and has been invited to collaborate with numerous Federal agencies and philanthropic foundations. For example, in 2010, he was appointed to the United States Department of Health and Human Services Secretary's Head Start Research and Evaluation Committee, and in 2016, to speak at the White House Early STEM Education Summit. At the Brazelton Touchpoints Center, his work has focused on cultural adaptations of family support programs, organizational professional development, cross-sector collaboration, and aligning systems of care with community strengths and priorities.
