

Wayzata High School Orchestras Perform March 21

Guest Artist: Chitravina Ravikiran, composer and virtuoso performer

East meets West as the world-class Indian musician [Chitravina Ravikiran](#) joins Wayzata High School's five orchestras for an evening of orchestral music at [the intersection of European harmony and Carnatic melody](#). This special concert takes place on **Tuesday, March 21 at 7:30 p.m.** in Auditorium 1 at Wayzata High School. The **Ninth Grade Orchestra** will play a handful of short selections, including *Avatar* by Doug Spada. **Sinfonia** will follow with the lovely *Fantasia on an Original Theme* and the lively opening movement of Boyce's *Symphony No.*

4.Camerata offers a similar contrast with *The Gift* by William Hofeldt and a short fugue from the pen of J.S. Bach. **String Orchestra** performs *La Folia*, a theme and variations modeled after Corelli, and *Bay of Bengal*, featuring Mr. Ravikiran as guest soloist. **Chamber Orchestra** partners with Mr. Ravikiran on two additional works, *A World View* and *Swagat-Home*, before concluding the concert with the final movement of Holst's *St. Paul Suite*. Tickets, available at the door, are \$5 for students/senior citizens and \$7 for adults. Credit cards, cash, and checks are accepted.
