

Super Mileage Vehicle Competition



The Super Mileage team competed this year at the State Competition held at the Brainerd Speedway in May. The team competed with one electric and three gasoline powered cars. The electric car did an impressive 2,312 miles per gallon equivalent run and all of the gasoline cars getting well over 130 miles per gallon.

The team builds one to two new cars per season from the ground up. The cars use Briggs and Stratton engines and bicycle type wheels, the cars are constructed from aluminum. The students design and build each car learning a variety of skills, such as, metal working, machining and welding. Congratulations!
