Culinary Express Reminder - Important End-of-Year Information



Students must have money in their account in order to purchase a lunch or a la carte items. Parents are still able to deposit funds into their student's lunch account through **June 8, 2017**.

The cost of a full-price lunch is \$2.90 for elementary schools, \$3.25 for middle schools, and \$3.80 for high school.

How do you check a student's balance? There are 5 ways to do this:

- 1. If you are set up with PayPams.com, your child's balance is updated every evening on the site. You can set up low-balance reminders to be emailed to you as well as check balances on the site.
- 2. Go to the Food Service tab in Skyward Family Access. Your child's balance and PIN are visible. These are also updated nightly.
- 3. At the elementary schools, watch for a red "smiley face" stamp on your child's hand. This is usually done when they have four meals or approximately \$10.00 left in their account.
- 4. Your child may ask the cashier for the balance.
- 5. Call the manager at the site and ask what your child's balance is. **Please do not call during lunchtime**; they are busy serving lunch. If you call in the evening, leave a voicemail with your phone number.

If you leave funds in your student's lunch account over the summer, it will be available in the fall when school opens.
