

The two ministry groups that will begin to use indoor building space are the specified **Worship Teams** and **Outreach Teams** listed below.

1. Worship Teams:

- A. (Chancel Chimers) Handbell Choir #1 - Group of 6
- B. (Chancel Chimers) Handbell Choir #2 - Group of 6
  - Both Handbell Choir teams will not practice/perform on the same date; they will rotate on a regular basis.
  - Collective singing of hymns/song by Handbell members during worship is not permitted at this time.
- C. Individual Musicians
  - Tom Paulson has recruited the following people to play an instrument during worship. Dates are to be determined.

2. Outreach Teams:

- A. Faithful Knotters
  - The quilting ministry is welcome to use the Sun Hall, Bethany Room and Family Restroom.
  - Room capacities
    - I. Sun Hall – 8
    - II. Bethany Room - 2
    - III. Bethany Room Closet – 1
  - Quilting tables will be set up in the Sun Hall and spaced apart to maintain at least 6 feet for social distancing.
  - Quilters will be asked to move their meeting time from every Monday to every other Wednesday.
    - I. The schedule change request will align with our current cleaning schedule.
    - II. Recommended length of time for gathering: 45-50 minutes per use.
    - III. No Food will be served during this ministry event.
- B. Faithful Knitters
  - The knitting ministry will be welcome to use the Couch Area at the North entrance, the Sun Hall and the Family Restroom.
  - Room capacity
    - I. North Entry Couch Area - 2
    - II. Sun Hall - 8
  - Previously the Knitters were scheduled in the evening. Knitters will be asked to move their meeting time to every other Wednesday opposite the Knotters.
  - Recommended length of time for gathering: 45-50 minutes per use.
  - No food will be served during this ministry time.
- C. Fare For All
  - Starting in November, we will move to an indoor model that will be limited to use of the Crown of Glory West Entrance, West Hallway and Family Restroom.
  - Area Capacities:
    - I. West Entrance – 4
  - Fare For All staff and volunteers may rotate being inside as needed.
  - No food will be served to Fare For All staff or volunteers during this ministry time.
- D. Kitchen Essentials Ministry
  - Currently collecting kitchen items offsite, items sporadically dropped off at church.
  - Limit of 2 people in the building to pick up kitchen items and deliver them offsite.
- E. Loaves & Fishes
  - Currently meets offsite at St. John's Lutheran Church in Shakopee.
  - Guidelines will be discussed if building use is requested.
