4th Congressional District (Open)

Madeleine Dean (D)

- Education: La Salle University; Widener University Law School.
- Served as a practicing attorney in the Philadelphia Area, was the Executive Director of the Philadelphia Trial Lawyers, and was an English Professor at La Salle University.
- Elected to the PA House of Representatives for the 153rd District in 2012.
- Per her campaign website biography, Dean is an “outspoken member, championing progressive priorities like public education, protecting the environment, combatting addiction, equal rights, access to health care, ethics, criminal justice reform, and gun violence.”

5th Congressional District (Meehan resigned)

- Currently the national Pro Bono Counsel at Ballard Spahr.

- Former Pennsylvania Secretary of Revenue under former Governor Tom Corbett (R)

13th Congressional District (The former Rep. Shuster Seat)
