ACKNOWLEDGEMENT of entries will be made as soon as practical. After closing armband numbers together with a copy of the Judging Program will be emailed.

A RECORDING FEE of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any AKC licensed or member club show, obedience or rally trial. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Instructions on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable. NO ENTRY shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES. Postdated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. NHOC will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
